

LANDSCAPE LOADER



Course Overview This training program consists of a classroom learning portion (approx. 4 hours) as well as a practical/hands-on learning portion (approx. 2-4 hours per student). Also known as a Farm Tractor, the Landscape Loader is a versatile machine that can be outfitted with a variety of attachments to meet specific task requirements. Regardless of the configuration it is vital that all operators receive training on the Landscape Loader in order to maximize their knowledge of the machine's capabilities and limitations.
