



RIGGING AND LIFTING

Course Overview This one-day course will cover the necessary safety requirements to properly:

- ▶ Rig loads for moving in and around the construction site
- ▶ Rig a load for lifting with heavy equipment
- ▶ Choose the right equipment for the right job, and
- ▶ Inspect equipment in order to ensure it meets the minimum safety requirements.

- ▶ Rigging inspection
- ▶ Hoisting
- ▶ Stability when lifting
