



CONFINED SPACE AWARENESS/ENTRY

Course Overview This training course covers the definition of a confined space and the applicable regulations. Topics covered vary depending on whether staff are entering confined spaces or working around them and may include:

- ▶ Changes to the OSHA regulations, including the definitions of a “Confined Space”
- ▶ Hazards of a confined space, and assessment
- ▶ Employer programs for confined space
- ▶ Planning for confined space entry
- ▶ Training and entry permits
- ▶ PPE and rescue equipment.

Who Should Attend: This is designed for all workers who may have to work in or around confined spaces and those in charge of workers entering confined space.

Learning Objectives: Upon completion of this program the participant will be able to:

- ▶ Recognize confined spaces in the work place
- ▶ Describe major hazards of confined spaces
- ▶ Identify controls required for confined space entry.

Evaluation/Documentation: Theory exam (multiple choice) and/or oral exam (by instructor). Each successful participant will be provided with a certificate of completion.
