



Mechanic

Reporting to the Fleet Supervisor, the Mechanic is responsible for troubleshooting, repair, and overhaul of a variety of Town fleet (including loaders, tractors, fires trucks, vehicles, small hand tools, etc.); performs preventive maintenance and inspection and documents service records for all Town fleet.

- Completes daily work orders and updates the Fleet Management System (Cityworks) with work performed including servicing and repairs, pre-operative inspections, parts, and preventative maintenance
- Performs preventative maintenance on vehicles and equipment to ensure they are in a safe operating condition
- Performs regular safety inspections to ensure vehicles meet the Ministry of Transportation standards
- Performs repairs to vehicles that have become disabled off site
- Installs vehicle accessories and safety equipment (chargers, alarms, lighting accessories, etc.)
- Conducts fabrication and repairs using MIG and arc welding techniques to properly design and repair all types of metals and their related structural components (i.e. plates, straps, braces)
- Purchases goods and materials as per the Town's Purchasing Policy

- Supply your own tools to perform duties
